

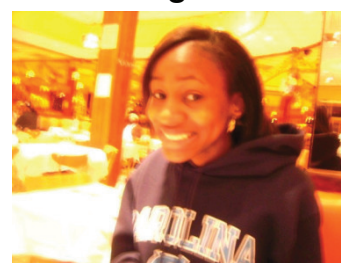

## Where Are They Now?

Let's see where some of our Lady Tar Heels are...

Coretta Brown is a native of Statesboro, GA and joined the Tar Heel Women's basketball team in 1999. She holds UNC's career record for the most three-pointers with 251 and is third in the ACC. Her three-



point percentage of .380 is also the best in school history. She graduated from UNC in 2003 and was the 11<sup>th</sup> pick in the 2003 WNBA draft. She was drafted by San Antonio and then traded to the Indiana Fever. Brown played three seasons with the Fever and then ended her WNBA career in 2006 with the Chicago Sky. After the WNBA, she spent two seasons with Georgia Tech as an administrative assistant. Brown then became an assistant coach for the Benjamin E. Mays varsity women's basketball team and helped lead the team to the Sweet 16 in Georgia. As of November 2009, she joined the staff of Tennessee Tech University as an assistant coach.
